

## ACADEMIC COACHING FOR EXCELLENCE IN SCHOLASTICISM (ACES)

Academic coaching will be available five days per week during or after school. The purpose of this program is to assist parents, students and teachers with communication, organization, study strategies and the academic challenges of the Middle School. Areas of concentration will include the following.

- Test Preparation
- Organization
- Homework Help
- Time Management
- Communication (parent/teacher/student)
- Advance Planning

Students are referred to this program by a teacher or the advisor. Parents may also request placement for their son or daughter. All students entering the ACES program must be approved by the division head. Enrollment for ACES students will be reviewed at the end of each term.

ACES is a required program once a student is enrolled. The ACES coach will take attendance daily and report any absences to the division head immediately. All extra help with content area teachers is scheduled by the ACES coach and all students enrolled in ACES must report to ACES prior to obtaining extra help.

**PLEASE NOTE: If your child is not enrolled in ACES,** they may still seek extra help from a content area teacher after school from 3:30-4:15 p.m. Extra help is not a drop-in program and all students wishing to stay after school to work with a teacher must make an appointment.

Students not picked up at 4:15 p.m. will be sent to Extended Day. Students must sign in upon arrival and sign out when dismissed. Charges will apply for this service.
